

Applications for the current application cycle for ArchCare at St. Teresa located at 139 Windsor Road, Staten Island must be post marked or emailed by 11:59 pm, Friday, March 15, 2019. All applications that are not submitted by March 15 will be placed on the waiting list for future review. The waiting list will include those not chosen as part of the current rent-up lottery and will be assigned a chronological place on the waiting list for future apartments based on the receipt date and time of the application.

ArchCare at St. Teresa is being created in the former convent of St. Teresa of the Infant Jesus Church to provide independent housing for young autistic adults. It will feature separate apartments with a combined living/dining/sleeping area, a bathroom and a small kitchen with a stove, refrigerator and microwave. A recreation area, community room, teaching kitchen, lounge and laundry will be shared by the residents. The building and apartments will have fire, smoke and emergency response alarms. The building will be fully sprinklered and will have a key fob access system.

Residents must be able to abide by the terms of a lease. No support services will be provided, but it is anticipated residents may receive services through self-directed funding and from Circles of Support.
