RE: Let's keep our community safe, together.

ArchCare at Manning Walsh Home is concerned for the ongoing welfare, safety, and health of our residents.

This letter is to alert you that from January 12th through today January 13th we are reporting that 7 residents have tested positive for COVID-19. We are following the latest CMS and CDC guidance for continued monitoring of this situation. We are actively screening all people who enter the building for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and are working with our local and state health departments.

All of our staff members continue to follow the CDC's recommendations to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. To minimize the risk of more of our residents becoming sick with COVID-19, we require that all visitors wear masks when traveling in the building. We will continue to be open for visitation.

We will cohort the affected residents and continue to follow the core principles of infection control. If you are not comfortable visiting in person, other ways to connect include telephone, email, text, or through Skype.
