This letter is to alert you that on March 24th^t 2023, we are reporting that 1 resident has tested positive for COVID-19. We are following the latest CMS and CDC guidance for continued monitoring of this situation. We are actively screening all people who enter the building for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and are working with our local and state health departments.

All of our staff members continue to follow the CDC's recommendations to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. We will cohort the affected residents and continue to follow the core principles of infection control.
