- » Team-based care management
- » 24/7 access to nurses and physicians
- » Adult day care with recreational and educational activities
- » Home care

Am I eligible to join ArchCare Senior Life?

You may be eligible to participate in the ArchCare Senior Life Specialized Care Program if:

- » You are 55 or older and were diagnosed with an intellectual or developmental disability
- » You qualify for Medicare and/or Medicaid or can pay privately
- » You are eligible for nursing home care but able to live safely at home with PACE assistance at the time of enrollment
- » Your healthcare needs can be met in your home and in our PACE centers
- » You reside in the ArchCare Senior Life service area, which currently includes Manhattan, the Bronx and Staten Island
- » You receive services from the New York State Office of People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD)
